1. Box Tops for Education

***Clip Box Tops** - Cut from eligible products and turn in to school office or church meeting room.

***The Marketplace** - Sign up at btfe.com to support school. Shop over 100 retail stores on-line- school earns up to 15% of transactions.

***The Reading Room** - Order books from Barnes & Noble by going through BTFE website first- school earns 6% back from new book sales and 3% on all other on-line purchases.

***My Class Essentials** - Teachers create registry of items needed for classroom. For every item purchased through BTFE Website school earns 2% of sale....and the classroom gets the purchased item!

(Piggy Bank holds cash contributions that teachers can use to purchase items from their list - after 12 months money not spent goes directly to school as BTFE check).

3. Thriftway Receipts (Grisillo's in Penn Mart Plaza)

Turn in receipts to school office or church meeting room.

4. Scrip Cards

With every gift card purchased, 2-15% of the amount purchased is contributed back to the school. You will benefit by receiving credit for half of this percentage back as a credit to your tuition. Our school receives the other half. More information regarding Scrip Cards is available at www.stpeternewcastle.org.

Bonus Use Scrip cards online after accessing merchants through Box Tops for Education Marketplace and school earns from BOTH programs. Thriftway cards may be purchased and receipts submitted and school earns from BOTH programs as well.

5. Recycle Paper

Drop off all paper to be recycled in green and yellow Paper Retriever Recycling Bins in parking lot. School receives money back each time bins are collected.

Please recycle your: Newspapers, Magazines, Mail, School & Office Papers, Catalogs, Phone Books, etc.

Shredded paper should be in a plastic garbage bag.

Please do NOT deposit any other recycling items, such as cardboard, in the bins.

6. Recycle Ink Cartridges and Toner

Drop off empty ink and toner cartridges to the school office. They will be recycled through the Staples Rewards Program. The school will earn \$3 reward (to be used for new purchases at Staples) for each one submitted.
